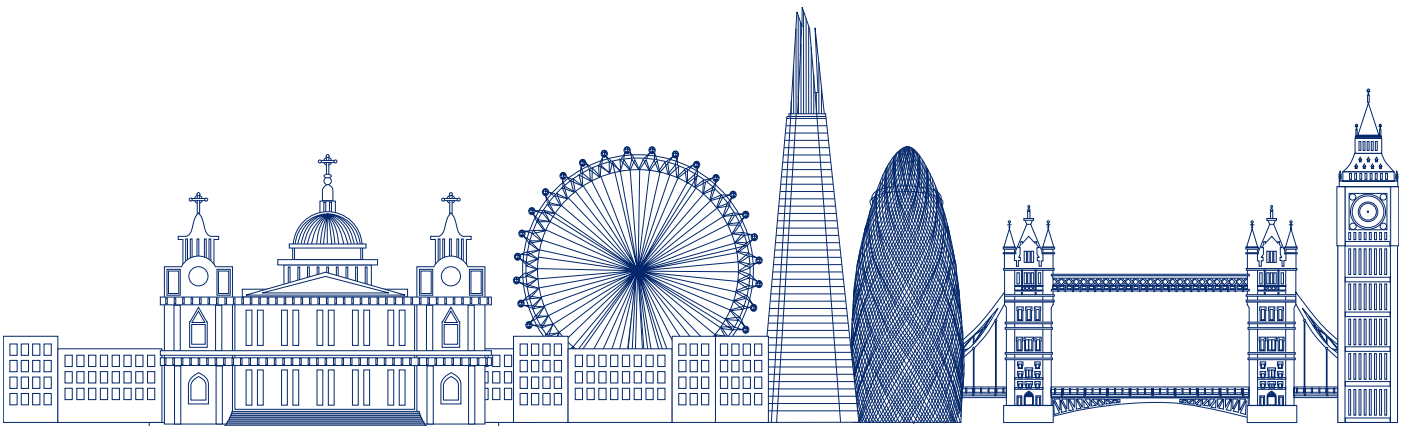

As a general rule, hotels, on a long term basis, will be expensive and you may want to seek accommodation in a house share/halls of residence as a cheaper alternative. Rates can vary according to time of year. As a general rule:

- Low season: ranges from October through to March
- Mid season: ranges from April through to end of May
- High Season: ranges from June through to September

**Note:** Christmas (December) and Easter (mid April) holiday periods are generally priced as high season, but may include slightly higher charges.

## 2. Longer Term Accommodation

There are several different types of accommodation available to students enrolled on a course at Le Cordon Bleu, these fall into the following categories:

- Student accommodation & halls of residence
- Private flats/houses through estate agents
- House or flat shares (can be arranged through an agency)
- Homestays with host families (organised via a dedicated agency)

When living in London, it is important to remember that the nearer you are to the centre of London, the more expensive it will be. So depending on your budget, be prepared to commute. (For a map of London's underground, please visit Transport for London website on [www.tfl.gov.uk](http://www.tfl.gov.uk) – the school is located close to Holborn tube station).

Please note that the duration of property leases vary in the UK, including:

- short term (less than 6 months)
- six monthly
- long term (minimum 12 months)

Rental rates will vary accordingly, with longer-term rates being the least expensive. It is advisable to check with the Estate Agent on lease conditions in advance.

## Transport

### Travelling to Central London from Different Airports

#### 1. Heathrow

Heathrow is approximately 15 miles west of central London.

##### By Rail

**Heathrow Express:** Trains scheduled from Heathrow to London Paddington (every 15 minutes)

**Journey time:** Approximately 15 minutes

**Price:** approximately £19 for a single journey

The first train from Heathrow Terminals 1 and 3 is 05.12 (Monday – Saturday) and 05.08 on Sunday. The last train leaves at 23.48 (Monday – Saturday) and 23.53 on Sunday.

The first train from Heathrow Terminal 4 is 5.23 (Monday – Saturday), and 5.53 on Sunday. The last train leaves at 23.41 each day.

The first train from Terminal 5 is 5.07 (Monday – Saturday) and 5.03 on Sunday. The last train leaves at 23.58.

You can get a London Black Cab outside Heathrow Airport, follow the signs to the taxi area. Taxis charge on a meter, and on average a journey to Central London takes approximately 30 minutes at a cost of approximately £45.

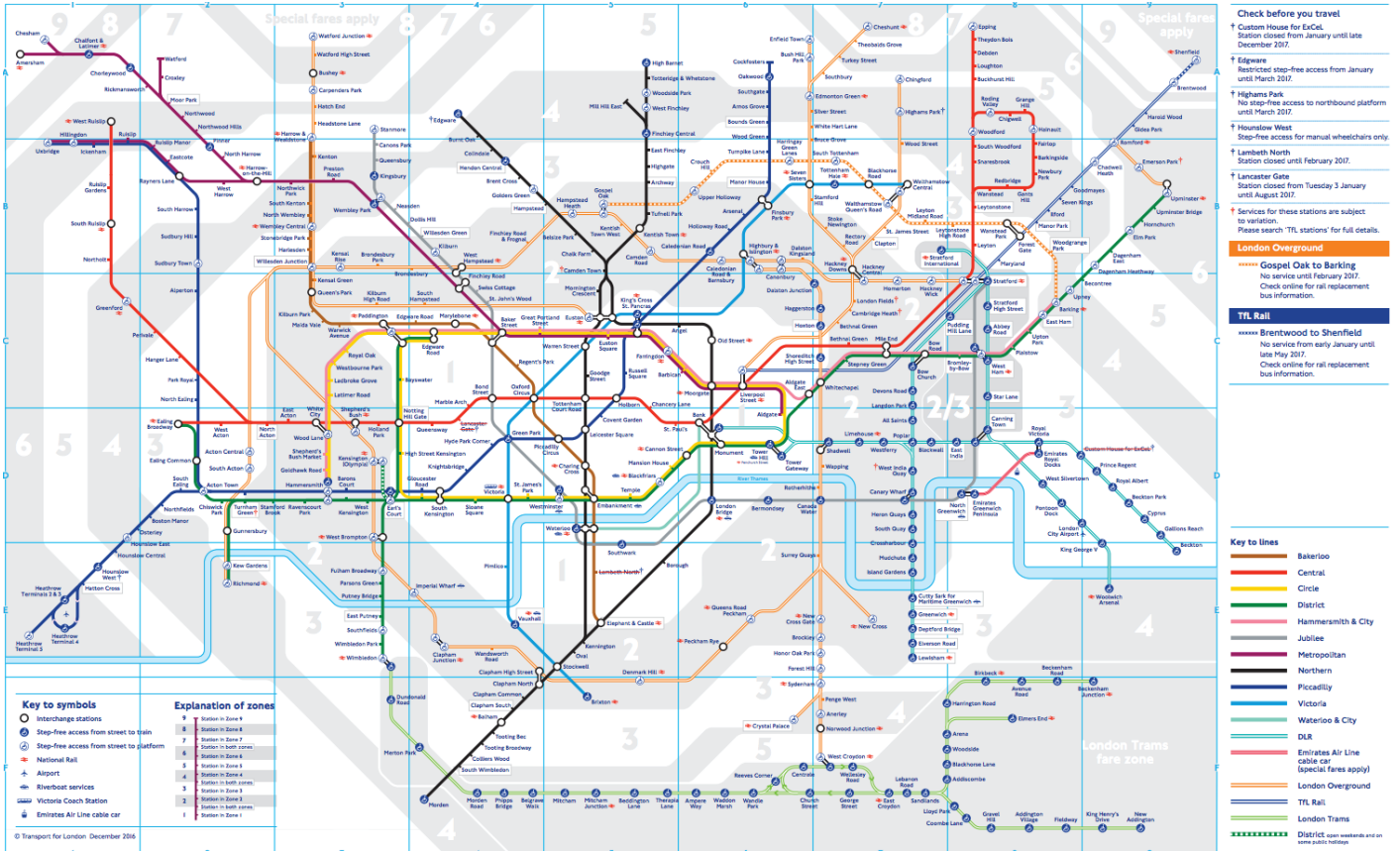

## Living in London: Practical information

### London Weather

#### Winter (from December to February):

Temperatures are usually around 0-6 degrees. Rain is common during the winter, and although snow is rare, it is advised to wear warm clothing throughout the season.

#### Spring (from March to May):

Weather conditions can be very unpredictable during the spring. Temperatures average around 11-15 degrees. There are occasional spring showers in March and April and it is wise to bring a waterproof coat.

#### Summer (from June to August):

Generally the summers are sunny with occasional rain. Temperatures average 20 degrees but it can sometimes be much warmer.

#### Autumn (from September to November):

This time of year is similar to spring. However summer can extend into September. A cold wind typically arrives around the end of October as the leaves start to fall.

### Health Advice: Frequently Asked Questions

#### Can I get free/reduced healthcare and hospital treatment whilst in the U.K?

Free or reduced treatment is available from the NHS (National Health Service) if you are from the EEA (European Economic Area) or Switzerland, or if you are from a country that has a bilateral healthcare agreement with the U.K.

For a list of nationalities qualifying for treatment, please check the Department of Health website [www.dh.gov.uk](http://www.dh.gov.uk) or call the Department of Health's Customer Service centre on +44 (0) 20 7210 4850.

#### Do I have to pay for emergency treatment if I have an accident?

Regardless of residential status or nationality, emergency treatment given at a GP (General Practitioners), Accident and Emergency wing of a hospital or walk-in centre is free of charge. However, if the patient is admitted formally as an in-patient including emergency operations and admittance to High Dependency Unit's or registered at an outpatient clinic, there will be a charge. It is highly recommended to obtain health insurance before arriving in the country, especially if you are not eligible to receive free treatment from the NHS.

#### Finding a doctor / optician / dentist / pharmacy or hospital around your home

The NHS provides an online directory on their website for all doctors, General Practitioners (GP), hospitals, walk-in centres, opticians, pharmacies and dentists in the UK. To view this directory, please visit [www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk) and type in your post code.

#### How do I register with a doctor?

You should register with a doctor in your local area as soon as you have found a permanent residence. Your GP will be attributed to you by your post code. Find out which GP you should visit using: [www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk) by entering your post code.

#### Specialist doctors, medicine prescriptions, walk-in centres, and other information

To see a specialist, you will need to get a referral from your GP. Your GP can also prescribe you medicine by writing a prescription which you then present at a pharmacy. If you are very ill and you cannot go to the surgery, it is possible to ask a doctor to visit your home. You can visit any walk-in centre during their opening hours without appointment. A nurse will give you basic medical advice or treatment for minor illnesses and injuries. For further advice: [www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk).
