KEY CREDIT VALUES

As a rule, LCBA uses the following values for granting credit for completion of AQF qualifications in a related field towards the course requirements of a Bachelor-level (AQF 7) qualification:

- Certificate III (AQF 3): up to 8% of the course requirements (or 0.25-year equivalent);
- Certificate IV (AQF 4): up to 17% of the course requirements (or 0.5-year equivalent);
- Diploma (AQF 5): up to 33% of the course requirements (or 1-year equivalent);
- Advanced Diploma (AQF 6): up to 50% of the course requirements (or 1.5-year equivalent); and
- Associate Degree (AQF 6): up to 67% of the course requirements (or 2-year equivalent).

As a rule, LCBA uses the following values for granting credit for completion of AQF qualifications in a related field towards the course requirements of a Master-level (AQF 9) qualification:

- Bachelor Degree (AQF 7): up to 25% of the course requirements (or 0.5-year equivalent);
- Graduate Certificate (AQF 8): up to 25% of the course requirements (or 0.5-year equivalent); and
- Graduate Diploma (AQF 8): up to 50% of the course requirements (or 1-year equivalent).

GENERIC ARTICULATIONS

The following table specifies the pathways (including admission and credit for prior learning) from a generic source program completed at a registered Australian institution to a given course at LCBA. The table must be read jointly with the relevant course rules and LCBA's *Credit Point Policy*.

Students should note that some majors may not be available due to advanced standing given for specified units and should consult with LCBA staff upon enrolment to confirm majors on offer. International students should note that advanced standing may impact on course duration: eligible students should consider an offer of advanced standing in light of potential impact on student visa requirements.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING FOR INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS – IF NOT GRANTED AS CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING

Industry placements, internships and other WIL-related activities associated with different units in a program may lead to recognition of prior learning granted in the form of satisfying part, or all, of WIL placement duration requirements provided that these activities qualify as industry experience and contribute to the attainment of the learning outcomes, or requirements, of the WIL unit. Students will still be required to complete assessments for WIL units. Industry experiences conducted outside of a program of study must be validated, and supporting information verified, for students to be eligible for advanced standing, credit transfer, or recognition of prior learning.

Recognition of prior learning for industry experience is independent from, and in addition to, any credit for prior learning granted for the selected course. The exemption to undertake a placement does not directly reduce the duration of a course as students are required to complete the unit assessments; however, students may be permitted to undertake concurrent units, thereby allowing a higher study workload for the trimester and reducing the overall course duration.

Students exempted from the placement duration are liable for the full tuition fee for the unit.
