Students who wish to undertake majors different to those listed in this Schedule may not be eligible for the full amount of potential credit for prior learning.

Students should note that some majors may not be available due to advanced standing given for specified units and should consult with LCBA staff upon enrolment to confirm majors on offer. International students should also note that advanced standing may impact on course duration: eligible students should consider an offer of advanced standing in light of potential impact on student visa requirements.

Specified units indicated in the table are subject to change and will be confirmed at time of enrolment in the LCBA course.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING FOR INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS — IF NOT GRANTED AS CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING

Industry placements, internships and other WIL-related activities associated with different units in a program may lead to recognition of prior learning granted in the form of satisfying part, or all, of WIL placement duration requirements provided that these activities qualify as industry experience and contribute to the attainment of the learning outcomes, or requirements, of the WIL unit. Students will still be required to complete assessments for WIL units. Industry experiences conducted outside of a program of study must be validated, and supporting information verified, for students to be eligible for advanced standing, credit transfer, or recognition of prior learning.

Recognition of prior learning for industry experience is independent from, and in addition to, any credit for prior learning granted for the selected course. The exemption to undertake a placement does not directly reduce the duration of a course as students are required to complete the unit assessments; however, students may be permitted to undertake concurrent units, thereby allowing a higher study workload for the trimester and reducing the overall course duration.

Students exempted from the placement duration are liable for the full tuition fee for the unit.
