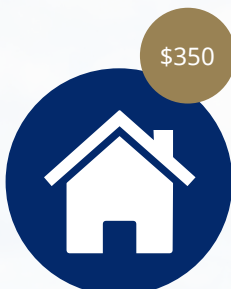


# WELLINGTON COST OF LIVING 2021

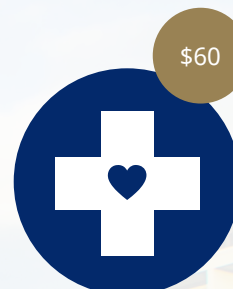
1-week rent in a central city apartment alone.
